

TITLE III: Public Health and Safety

ARTICLE 2. Nuisance (revised by ordinance 2005-01)

Section 1. Discharge of Fireman Prohibited

(a) It shall be unlawful and prohibited for any person to point, aim, fire, or discharge or to permit or allow to be pointed, aimed, fired, or discharged, a firearm or any other similar weapon or device of any type within the corporate limits of the Town of Bloomfield, Indiana

(b) The regulations and prohibitions set forth in this section shall not apply to law enforcement, military, or other authorized personnel in the performance of their official duties. Further, the regulations and prohibitions set forth in this section shall not apply to the discharge of a fireman in a lawful defense of person or property, or otherwise permitted by law.

(c) Definitions

“Firearm” shall mean any device that will expel a projectile and includes any such device commonly referred as a pistol, revolver, rifle, gun or shotgun.

(d) Violations of this section shall be punishable as follows:

First violation shall result in a fine of \$100.00
Subsequent violations shall result in a fine of \$200.00
